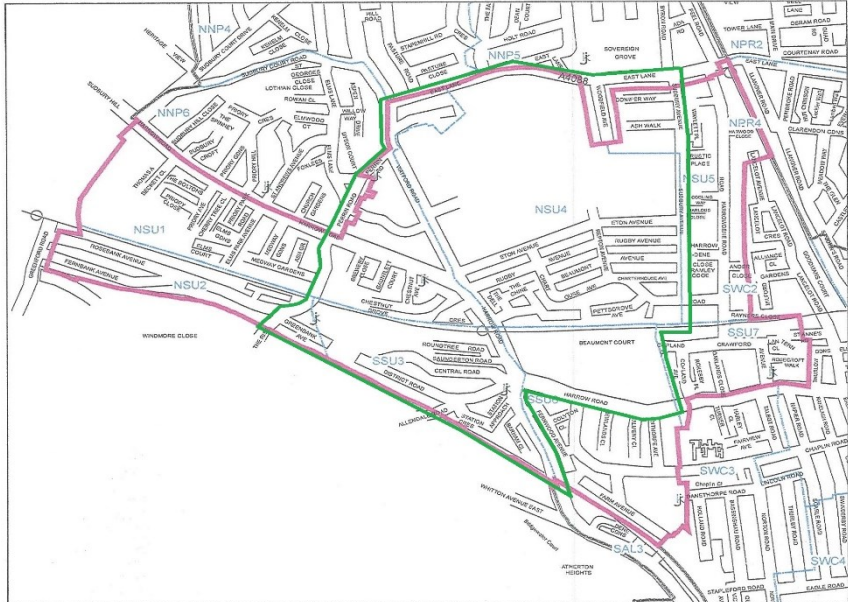

### Neighbourhood Plan

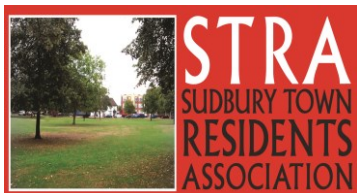
**What is a neighbourhood plan?** It is a local plan for local people with a shared vision for their neighbourhood. Neighbourhood planning is a way for communities to have a say in the future of the places where they live and work. It is an important and powerful tool that gives communities statutory powers to help shape their local area. It helps choose where you want new homes, shops and offices to be built. It is a document that sets out planning policies for your area and encourages better designed places and housing that genuinely meets local needs. In 2015 STRA, with the support of our community, we worked hard to secure a neighbourhood plan and was the first to do so in Brent. Your Neighbourhood Plan protects our local green spaces from development – Vale Farm, Maybank Open Space, Barham Park and Butlers Green.

### What have Sudbury Town Residents' Association (STRA) achieved?

**STRA achievement highlights:** Stopped flats being built on Sudbury Town Station Car Park; reinforced protection of our green spaces in 2021; public toilets outside Sudbury and Harrow Road Station; 16 trees on the High Street; raised £20,000 from City Hall for the Neighbourhood Plan; Litter picks since 2011; free weekly cricket sessions for children in local schools; Christmas Celebrations at the Swan and Sudbury Primary School; supporting our local East Lane Theatre; and *much much more* .... STRA has achieved a brilliant reputation for being the VOICE of the community. Whatever impacts our community is of concern to STRA.

### FORUM RENEWAL CONSULTATION

**The VOICE of the FORUM is More powerful than the individual  
 Make your voice heard before 23 February 2023**

Does Sudbury Town look like Alperton, Wembley Central or Wembley Park? There are 6,000 new homes planned in Northwick Park but none in Sudbury Town.

There has been no development in Sudbury Town because of the Planning Policy created by STRA called the Sudbury Town Neighbourhood Plan. It protects our area and stops excessive development.

If we change the Plan or make a new Plan, we lose this protection.

STRA was granted legal planning rights as Forum in 2012. STRA Forum has been the voice of the residents and businesses for 10 years and we have applied to the Council to renew. If STRA's Forum status is not renewed the VOICE of the community will be silenced. Forum status provides the community with a legal voice to preserve our green spaces, to voice our concerns with the building of high rises, to improve transport in the area, to speak collectively for the community when confronted with issues that are detrimental to the area or controversial ..... Sudbury in Bloom, Litter picking, Paan spitting, Antisocial behaviour, Street drinking, saving the Sudbury Town Car Park and more .....
